



## **MLA Ellis Ross retains high profile critic role for LNG**

TERRACE (September 10, 2020) – Skeena MLA Ellis Ross will continue his work in the high profile post as Official Opposition Critic for LNG, Resource Opportunities, and Responsible Development, as the BC Liberals make changes to critic roles today to focus major economic areas in the face of COVID-19.
