## **MLA Marvin Hunt named Opposition Critic for Citizens' Services**

SURREY-CLOVERDALE (September 10, 2020) – BC Liberal Leader Andrew Wilkinson has named Surrey-Cloverdale MLA Marvin Hunt as the new Official Opposition Critic for Citizens' Services as the BC Liberals made changes to critic roles today. As the NDP government drags their feet responding to challenges posed by COVID-19, the Official Opposition's critic shuffle today signals their commitment to hold John Horgan and his government to account in key areas.

“I'm looking forward to my new role as the Official Opposition Critic for Citizens' Services where I will continue to push the NDP government to improve access to information, protection of privacy, and expand high-speed internet service to all communities in B.C.,” said Hunt. “These issues have been highlighted by the pandemic as more people work remotely and as more students learn online. I will push the NDP government to develop strategies to ensure our province has the infrastructure and resources to meet the future needs of families and businesses. ”

The critic role changes announced today build on the 13 letters and over 60 policy suggestions introduced by the BC Liberals over the last several months to help B.C. combat the effects of COVID-19 on people and the economy, and get the province back on track.

“Marvin Hunt has been a key community advocate for a long time, and I'm certain that he will work diligently to make the NDP government deliver the services that people count on,” added BC Liberal Leader Andrew Wilkinson. “We've listened to thousands of British Columbians over the summer about their concerns as we come up with policy suggestions to help families make ends meet and help businesses survive. The NDP government has so far failed in fulfilling their

commitment to making life more affordable but we will not stop in speaking up for British Columbians for a plan that enables everyone to reach their full potential."
